Secretary of State Cortés-Vázquez has forwarded to me your May 5, 2008 correspondence questioning the unfair labor practices of Cambridge Security.

I have reviewed your file relative to your complaint. Although Article 7 and 7a of the General Business Law gives this agency the authority to take disciplinary action against private investigators or watch guard and patrol agencies, such action is not warranted in this instance, as the matter is currently being litigated by the Attorney General's Office and further investigation of such matters are within the purview of the Labor Department.

Accordingly, we are suggesting you consult the respective agencies regarding the matter in question.
